I. Parent Policy and Code of Conduct During Training Sessions

At MK Fencing Academy, we are committed to providing a positive, safe, and focused environment for all our fencers. To ensure the best possible experience for your child and all participants, we kindly ask parents to adhere to the following guidelines during training sessions:

1. Respect the Training Environment:

- Parents are to remain seated in the designated area provided within the academy venue. This helps maintain a calm and orderly environment, allowing coaches and fencers to focus on their training.

2. No Interference on the Piste:

- Parents should not interfere with or engage with their child or any other fencers while they are on the piste (the fencing area) during training. This includes giving instructions, coaching, or distracting the fencers in any way.

3. Respect the Coaching Staff:

- Trust in the expertise of the coaching staff. Parents should refrain from offering advice or questioning the methods used during training sessions. Any concerns should be addressed privately with the coach after the session.

4. Encouragement Over Criticism:

- Parents are encouraged to support and motivate their child through positive reinforcement. Avoid negative comments or criticism that could undermine the fencer's confidence or the coach's authority.

5. Sportsmanship:

- Parents should always exhibit good sportsmanship by respecting all participants, coaches, and other parents. Any form of unsportsmanlike behavior, including arguing with coaches, other parents, or fencers, is strictly prohibited.

II. Parent Policy and Code of Conduct During Official Events

When attending official events, such as competitions and tournaments, MK Fencing Academy expects parents to uphold the highest standards of conduct. This ensures that our fencers can compete in a supportive and respectful environment. The following rules apply:

1. Remain Seated and Respectful:

- Parents are to remain seated in the designated spectator areas and should not approach the piste during matches. This includes refraining from approaching referees, coaches, or fencers during the bout.

2. No Interference or Coaching:

- Parents must not engage with their child or any other fencer while they are on the piste during official events. Coaching, shouting instructions, or offering advice is strictly prohibited. Allow the coaching staff to provide guidance.

3. Demonstrate Good Sportsmanship:

- Applaud and encourage all competitors, regardless of the outcome. Show respect for referees' decisions, even if they do not favour your child. Unsportsmanlike behaviour, such as arguing with officials, booing, or any form of negative commentary, is unacceptable.

4. Support the Team:

- Parents are encouraged to support not just their child but the entire MK Fencing Academy team. Positive reinforcement and a team-first attitude are key to fostering a strong, supportive community.
